Designed to expand on the student's knowledge and skills in the application of Clinical Operative Dentistry. Instruction is focused on the development of more advanced skills in diagnosis, treatment planning, and treatment procedures.

Clinic: Study of diagnosis, treatment planning, and intracoronal dental therapy, including preparation for and restoration of teeth with cast gold and porcelain inlays and onlays, composite resins, laminates, and amalgam in comprehensive clinical dental practice.
