

101441 Partial Removable Prosthodontics (2)

[3 cr., 2, 3 cl.] The study of diagnosis, treatment planning, and removable prosthodontic treatment that restores masticatory function and phonetics, preserves underlying structures, results in patient comfort, and is esthetically pleasing. Course designed for diagnosis and treatment planning, clinical examination, preliminary impression and diagnostic casts.

Preparation mouth and teeth for RPP.

Clinic: This course provides training in clinical procedures for the construction of and partial dentures. It also helps develop skills to improve clinician/patient relations and hence aid in success of treatment.
