

101442 Complete Removable Prosthodontics (1)

[3 cr., 2, 3 cl.] This course deals with the essential theoretical principles and concepts of complete denture prosthodontics; including patient selection, examination, and preparation for treatment, impressions, bite registration, try in and the final delivery of the denture. It also emphasizes the importance of clinician/patient relations as a factor in success of treatment. In addition an account of the etiology, disabilities and oral rehabilitation of patients with congenital, acquired and developmental maxillofacial defects is provided.

Clinic: This course provides training in clinical procedures for the construction of complete dentures. It also helps develop skills to improve clinician/patient relations and hence aid in success of treatment.
