

101461 Orthodontics (2)

[3 cr., 2, 3] The course provides an in depth account of diagnosis and treatment of all malocclusion classes including specific problems like impacted canines and incisors. It highlights concepts of interceptive orthodontic measures that can be dealt with by general dental practitioners. An introduction to the basic management principles of combined orthodontic /orthognathic treatment and cleft lip and palate patients is also provided.

Lab: The course concentrates on providing students with basic diagnostic skills needed for orthodontic assessment of patients, including cephalometric analysis. Data collected from patient assessments will be used to develop a treatment plan. Special consideration will be given to identifying those patients that can be treated with removable appliances.
