

101472 Dental Pediatric (1)

[3 cr., 2, 3 cl.] An introductory course on methods of examination, assessment and treatment of pediatric dental patients. Normal development of the primary dentition and prevention. Presents the basic methods to restore primary teeth and diagnosis and management of arch length in children.

Clinic: Develops clinical skills necessary for the management of pediatric patients in the dental setting with special emphasis on behaviorally difficult patients. The course introduces methods of treatment of pediatric patients with carious, pulpally involved and traumatized teeth with special emphasis on making children at ease in the dental chair. It also introduces students to diagnosis and treatment of oral pathology in pediatric dental patients.
