

101521 Radiographic Diagnosis

[3 cr., 2, 2 cl.] This is an advanced course concentrating on differentiating between different pathological lesions and recognition of abnormal radiographic appearances. Special emphasis is given to more complicated radiolucent, radio opaque and mixed lesions.

Clinic: Students continue to refine their skills by taking intraoral and panoramic radiography on clinic patients. A systematic approach to interpretation of oral radiographs and documentation of diagnostic findings. Through the practical section of this course, the students will be trained to master the interpretation of normal vs. pathologic radiographic appearance of structure of the maxilla and mandible.
