

101544 Fixed Prosthodontics (4)

[3 cr., 2, 2 cl.] This course emphasizes the fundamental skills needed for the fabrication of fixed prosthetic restorations: making of alginate impressions and study casts, introduction to articulators, preparation design for ceramo-metal crowns, waxing, casting finishing and polishing techniques for gold castings, provisional and alternative provisional restorations.

Clinic: This course covers the diagnosis, treatment planning, and delivery of fixed prosthodontic treatment that addresses the patient's esthetic dental needs; stabilizes, improves, and protects the patients' gnathostomatic system in a comprehensive clinical dental practice. Students participate in quality assessment at clinical impression stage and at prosthesis delivery.
