

101545 Fixed Prosthodontics (5)

[1 cr., 0, 2 cl.] This course introduces the student to advanced techniques and difficult treatment concepts in fixed prosthodontics. Pulp biology is explored as it relates to prosthodontics. The course presents the most advanced concepts in aesthetic dentistry. In this course students will manage patients who need fixed prosthodontics treatment. All the clinical procedures will be followed : diagnosis and treatment plan, tooth preparation, impression making, temporization, fit, cementation of the restoration, and follow up care.
