

## **101546 Complete Removable Prosthodontics (2)**

[3 cr., 2, 3 cl.] An advance clinical course dealing with comprehensive management of a variety of cases in removable prosthodontics including overdenture, complete dentures, immediate dentures and transitional dentures. Emphasis will be placed on diagnosis, treatment planning, and the subsequent completion of the proposed treatment.

**Clinic:** In a comprehensive care setting, students are expected to further refine diagnostic and clinical skills in treating patients needing complete dentures.

Complete denture care often involves patients requiring single dentures opposing natural dentition or modifications thereof. Students complete clinical competency evaluations demonstrating the knowledge and application of treatment procedures for edentulous patients.
