[3 cr., 3, 0] This course is a foundation course that gives students an insight into the dynamics of the economy and prepares them to have a deeper understanding of the consumers as a whole, producers as a whole, and the effects of government spending and taxation policies as well as the effects of the monetary policy. Macroeconomics also discusses the causes and effects of unemployment, inflation, and the business cycle on the economy as a whole.
