

701272 Oral Histology (2)

[3 cr., 2, 2] The oral histology segment gives the student a thorough understanding of the microscopic structure of normal oral cavity tissues including: teeth, periodontal ligament, jaws, muscles, salivary glands and oral mucosa and thereby provides an important source oral physiology for decisions about dental treatments. This segment is crucial to prepare the student for studying oral pathology.

Lab: In the practice laboratory, students will study under the light microscope all the oral cavity normal tissues and draw them in their booklet using the special H&E drawing pencils.
