

## **701452 Oral and Dental Pathology (2)**

[3 cr., 2, 2] The oral cavity is a frequent target of primary and metastatic malignancies as well as complications related to cancer therapy. Unless recognized early and effectively managed, such complications may become so severe as to preclude further cancer therapy and thereby jeopardize the patient's chances for survival. The primary objective of this course is to enable students to recognize head and neck oral cancer, make appropriate referrals to the oral complications secondary to cancer treatment.

**Lab:** The students are going to study through light microscope different complicated oral tissues abnormalities, benign and malignant tumors; draw the histopathological view of these disorders in the students booklets using the special H&E drawing pencils.
