

## **703311 General Surgery for Dental**

[3 cr., 2, 2] Dental students should be able to understand human disease as far as it is relevant to the practice of dentistry. This course provides the student with an awareness of the major clinical features of common medical and surgical disorders.

**Lab:** clinical demonstrations and emphasis on medical and surgical conditions likely to be encountered by dental practitioners. Study of the principles of mucoperiosteal flap design, biopsy techniques, suturing, use of flaps, bone removal, and tooth sectioning for exodontia; apicoectomy in endodontic surgery and osseous surgery. Soft tissue grafting in periodontics will also be demonstrated.
